Primary: Largemouth bass

● MIDWEEK OUTLOOK

NWS ILN (Columbus, OH) for the pin: **Monday** ~67°F, Showers And Thunderstorms (~79% precip); **Tuesday** ~68°F, Mostly Cloudy (~8% precip); **Wednesday** ~65°F, Rain Showers Likely (~58% precip); **Thursday** ~67°F, Slight Chance Rain Showers then Partly Sunny (~23% precip). Times in this Cast are Eastern Time (ET). This Cast window is **Mon morning through Thu evening** — weekend leftovers are outside scope.

Primary species focus: **Largemouth bass** (localized, not bass-by-default). Forage cue: Shad / bluegill — creek arms and standing timber hold bait after cool nights. Dam/current: USACE Alum Creek Dam — check IEM/USACE pool before launching.

USACE Alum Creek Dam — check IEM/USACE pool before launching.

Re-check boards evening-before and morning-of. Access: ODNR Alum Creek State Park ramps (Delaware Co.).

● HOW TO FISH IT — BANK / KAYAK / BOAT

BANK

Park shoreline pockets;
focus shade and laydowns
early.

KAYAK

Protected creek arms best
when main lake chops.

BOAT

Graph creek channel swings;
soft plastics / spinnerbaits
on timber edges.

TOP

Walking bait / popper at dawn

Buzzbait on cloudy edges

Whopper-style for wind ripples

MID

Spinnerbait / chatter on points

Fluke / soft jerk (shad)

Squarebill on rock / wood

BOTTOM

Jig / creature in cover

Ned / shaky on clear rock

Dropshot when pressured

• BASS LIFE STAGE + WHAT'S ON THE MENU

Primary: Largemouth bass — late-summer / early-fall transition into midweek cool-down. Fish relating to bait and shade / current depending on water.

What's on the menu: Shad / bluegill — creek arms and standing timber hold bait after cool nights.

• ALSO HOT / ALSO IN SEASON

- **Crappie** — in season / bycatch on this water
- **Hybrid striped bass** — in season / bycatch on this water
- **Channel catfish** — in season / bycatch on this water

Localized primary species policy LOCKED — not bass-by-default.

• HEAVY TRAFFIC

Watch: Metro Columbus weekend leftovers; Mon–Thu usually quieter. Check ODNR calendar.

No named national trail weigh-in confirmed for this Mon–Thu window at gather time — re-check local club calendars morning-of. Commercial / recreation traffic still applies on rivers and destination lakes.
